Resolved, That Catharine R. Doherty of Boston, widow of Michael F. Doherty, who served in the United States anavy during the war of the rebellion and who, at date of enlistment therein was a citizen of Massachusetts, shall, from and after the passage of this resolve, be eligible to receive state or military aid under the provisions, rules and limitations of chapters three hundred and one and two hundred and seventy-nine of the acts of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-nine, in the same manner and to the same extent that she would have been had her late husband served to the credit of this Common-12 wealth.
