### AN ACT

To prevent Sales of Intoxicating Liquor upon premises where Billiards, and other Games are played.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Each license to sell intoxicating  
2 liquor shall be subject to the further condition,  
3 that the licensee shall not sell nor deliver by him-  
4 self, servant or agent, any intoxicating liquor in  
5 any store or room where billiards, pool, scipio or  
6 other games, including games of cards and dice,  
7 are played.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
