RESOLVE

In Aid of the State Normal School at Framingham.

1 *Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the
2 treasury of the Commonwealth a sum not exceeding
3 twelve hundred dollars, for the purpose of providing
4 stand pipes and hose, and water and drain for water
5 from the roof of the normal school building at Framing-
6 ham, for repairs and furniture for the boarding hall and
7 for electroliers and telephone at said school; the amount
8 to be expended under the direction of the state board of
9 education.
