AN ACT

To permit the Foxborough Water Supply District to Supply Water to Residents of Foxborough outside the District.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The water commissioners of the
2 Foxborough water supply district may furnish
3 and sell water to residents or inhabitants of the
4 town of Foxborough living outside of the Fox-
5 borough water supply district, on such terms and
6 conditions as shall be determined and authorized
7 by a two-thirds vote of the legal voters of the
8 Foxborough water supply district present and
9 voting thereon at a legal meeting called for that
10 purpose.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
