AN ACT

To authorize the Central Massachusetts Railroad Company to Issue Bonds.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The Central Massachusetts Rail-
2 road Company, in payment for expenditures for
3 permanent additions and improvements upon its
4 railroad and its furniture and equipment made
5 pursuant to its lease to the Boston and Lowell
6 Railroad Corporation dated December seven,
7 eighteen hundred and eighty-six, is hereby em-
8 powered, subject to the provisions of chapter one
9 hundred and twelve of the Public Statutes and of
10 any acts in amendment thereof, to issue bonds to
11 an amount not exceeding at the par value thereof,
12 the sum of five hundred thousand dollars.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
