SENATE, April 23, 1886.

The Committee on State House, to whom was referred the order relating to inquiring into the cause of the recent elevator accident, and into the safety of the elevators and the efficiency of the elevator service, report that they have had several meetings at which they have examined several experts in the construction of elevators, have had the Commissioners on the State House before them, and gone thoroughly into the matter, and from the evidence presented, voted unanimously to condemn the present elevators as now constructed, and would recommend the adoption of the following Resolve.

RESOLVE

Providing for remodelling the Elevators in the State House.

1 *Resolved*, That the commissioners on the State House
2 be authorized to contract with Otis Brothers and Com-
3 pany, for remodelling and putting into proper condition
4 the elevators in the State House, in accordance with
5 plans and specifications now in the hands of the commis-
6 sioners on the State House, at an expense not exceeding
7 forty-three hundred dollars, the work to be done under
8 the direction of the commissioners on the State House,
9 as provided for by section twelve of chapter five, Public
10 Statutes.
