### AN ACT

To amend Chapter One Hundred and Three of the Public Statutes, relating to District and other Police Officers.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section seven of chapter one hun-  
2 dred and three of the Public Statutes is amended  
3 by striking out the words "their respective cities,"  
4 in the third line, and inserting in place thereof the  
5 words "the United States."

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
