### AN ACT

To confirm certain Acts done by George T. Knox of San Francisco, in the State of California, as Commissioner for Massachusetts.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. All acts done by George T.  
2 Knox of San Francisco, in the state of California,  
3 as commissioner for this Commonwealth, within  
4 and for said state, between the nineteenth day of  
5 April in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-  
6 five and the twenty-second day of May in the  
7 year eighteen hundred and eighty-six, are hereby  
8 confirmed and made valid to the same extent as  
9 if during that time he had been duly appointed  
10 and qualified to perform the duties of that office.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
