AN ACT

To provide for the Disposition of the Property of the Corporation known as the Mission Park Association.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The next annual meeting of the
2 Mission Park Association, incorporated and or-
3 ganized by and under chapter five of the acts of
4 the general court, passed in the year eighteen
5 hundred and fifty-seven, entitled "An Act to
6 incorporate the Mission Park Association," shall
7 be held in the chapel of Williams College at Wil-
8 liamstown, at ten o'clock in the forenoon of the
9 day next preceding the next annual commence-
10 ment of Williams College. Said meeting shall
11 be notified by a call, signed by Mark Hopkins or
12 by Franklin Carter or by any justice of the peace,
13 and published at least twice in some daily news-
14 paper, published in each of the cities of Boston

15 and New York, the last publication to be at least
16 three weeks prior to the day of said meeting
17 Said meeting shall be called to order by Mark
18 Hopkins, or by any justice of the peace.

1 SECT. 2. The said Mission Park Association
2 may constitute and authorize an agent to convey
3 to the president and trustees of Williams College,
4 the real estate conveyed to the said Mission Park
5 Association by Charles Stoddard, on the nine-
6 tenth day of September, in the year eighteen
7 hundred and fifty-nine, to be held by the said
8 president and trustees in trust for the purposes
9 mentioned in said act of incorporation, and upon
10 the completion and acceptance of such convey-
11 ance, the said president and trustees of Williams
12 College shall succeed to the powers and privi-
13 leges conferred by said act upon the said Mission
14 Park Association.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
