AN ACT

To provide for the Service of Processes in favor of
or against Sheriffs.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 SECTION 1. A writ or process which is sued
2 out in favor of or against a sheriff shall be served
3 or executed by the sheriff or a deputy sheriff of
4 an adjoining county.

1 SECT. 2. Section twenty of chapter twenty-
2 five of the Public Statutes is repealed.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
