In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-five.

AN ACT

To authorize an Assignee of a Chose in Action to bring Suit in his own Name.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Every action founded upon a
2 chose in action which has been assigned, shall be
3 brought in the name of the assignee, and he
4 shall have the like remedies, to recover thereon,
5 as the assignor might have had if no assignment
6 had been made; the fact of the assignment, with

7 the name of the assignor, shall be stated in the
8 writ.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon the
2 first day of July in the year eighteen hundred
3 and eighty-five.
