AN ACT

Relative to holding Probate Courts the terms of which occur on Legal Holidays.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. Whenever the time of holding a
2 probate court as now prescribed by statute, shall
3 occur upon a legal holiday, said court shall be held
4 the next secular day thereafter, and all citations
5 and matters returnable on such holiday shall be
6 held and deemed returnable on said next secular
7 day, and all acts and proceedings of said court
8 done on said next secular day, shall have the
9 same force and validity as if done at a regular
10 term of said court.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
