AN ACT

To extend the Limitation of Time for the Payment of State Aid to Invalid Pensioners and their Dependent Relatives.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECTION 1. The limitation of time for the
2 payment of state aid named in sections two and
3 nine of chapter thirty of the Public Statutes is
4 hereby extended to the first day of January
5 eighteen hundred and ninety; and all the provis-
6 ions of said chapter in any way relating to the
7 payment of state aid to invalid pensioners and
8 their dependent relatives, shall remain and con-
9 tinue in force as they now are, till the said first
10 day of January eighteen hundred and ninety.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect on the first
2 day of January eighteen hundred and eighty-
3 five.
