AN ACT

To confirm the Proceedings of the Last Annual
Town Meeting of the Town of Royalston.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in
General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as
follows:*

1 SECTION 1. The proceedings of the annual
2 town meeting of the town of Royalston, held on
3 the first Monday of March, in the year eighteen
4 hundred eighty-four, shall not be invalid for the
5 reason that the tellers appointed to aid in check-
6 ing the names of voters, and in assorting and
7 counting the votes, were not sworn, and the elec-
8 tion of the town officers at said meeting is ratified
9 and confirmed.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
