FURTHER AMENDMENTS TO THE BILL IN RELATION TO THE
CAPE COD SHIP CANAL COMPANY. (SENATE, No. 256.)

Mr. LORING of Worcester moves to amend the bill by adding a new section next preceding the last section, as follows:—

1 SECT. . The provisions of sections sixty-
2 one and ninety-four to one hundred and twelve,
3 inclusive, of chapter one hundred and twelve of
4 the Public Statutes shall apply to said Cape Cod
5 Ship Canal Company.

Mr. LIVERMORE moves to amend the bill by adding to section eight the following:—

1 But, except that the canal company shall so
2 change the existing contract for the building of
3 the canal as to make the same apply to any lawful
4 change in the location thereof, the said existing
5 contract shall not be annulled nor altered, either
6 as to the price to be paid for said building or in
7 any other particular, except with the approval of

8 the board of harbor and land commissioners;
9 and no stock shall be issued to the contractor or
10 any other person under said contract until five
11 miles of said canal shall have been completed pur-
12 suant to its terms.
