## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-three.

### AN ACT

To Extend the Charter of the Ocean Terminal Railroad, Dock and Elevator Company, and to Revive, Confirm and Extend the Charter of the Ocean Terminal Railroad Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. All the provisions of chapter two  
2 hundred and thirty-nine of the acts of the year  
3 eighteen hundred and eighty-one, entitled, "An  
4 Act to incorporate the Ocean Terminal Railroad,  
5 Dock and Elevator Company," and all the pro-  
6 visions of chapter ninety-one of the acts of the  
7 year eighteen hundred and eighty-two, entitled,  
8 "An Act relating to the Ocean Terminal Railroad,  
9 Dock and Elevator Company," are hereby con-  
10 tinued in force, and the said company may be or-  
11 ganized at any time before the sixth day of May,  
12 eighteen hundred and eighty-five, and the time

13 within which the terms and conditions of the pur-  
14 chase by said corporation, authorized in section  
15 four of said chapter two hundred and thirty-nine,  
16 may be agreed upon, is hereby extended to said  
17 sixth day of May, eighteen hundred and eighty-  
18 five.

1   SECT. 2. The charter of the Ocean Terminal  
2 Railroad Company, organized under the general  
3 laws of this Commonwealth, is hereby revived,  
4 its organization ratified and confirmed, and the  
5 time for completing its railroad extended to the  
6 sixth day of May, eighteen hundred and eighty-  
7 five.

1   SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
