RESOLVE

In favor of the State Primary School at Monson.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth the sum of four hundred and one dollars and ninety-six cents, being the unexpended balance of an appropriation authorized by the resolves of the year eighteen hundred and eighty-one, chapter sixty, for the erection and completion of a new hospital at the state primary school at Monson; said amount being necessary for the completion of the hospital, and having reverted to the treasury according to law; the same to be expended under the direction of the trustees of the state primary and reform schools.
