### RESOLVE

In favor of the State Lunatic Hospital at Danvers.

*Resolved,* That there be allowed and paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth, to the trustees of the State Lunatic Hospital at Danvers, the sum of fifteen thousand five hundred dollars, to be expended for the following purposes: twelve thousand dollars for the erection and completion of a new laundry; and thirty-five hundred dollars for painting and necessary repairs on said hospital.
