### AN ACT

To amend Chapters Eighty-Four and Eighty-Six of the Public Statutes relating to Indigent and Neglected Children.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Section twenty-one of chapter  
2 eighty-four of the Public Statutes is amended by  
3 inserting after the word "asylum," in the fourth  
4 line, the words, "or St. Mary's Infant Asylum."

1 SECT. 2. Section forty-four of chapter eighty-  
2 six of the Public Statutes is amended by inserting  
3 after the word "charter," in the third line, the fol-  
4 lowing words: "or to the St. Mary's Infant  
5 Asylum agreeably to the provisions of its charter."

1 SECT. 3. The provisions of section forty-six  
2 of chapter eighty-six of the Public Statutes, as

3 amended by chapter one hundred eighty-one of  
4 the acts of the year eighteen hundred eighty-two,  
5 shall apply to the St. Mary's Infant Asylum.

1    SECT. 4. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
