Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty-three.

AN ACT

To enforce the Attendance of Witnesses before
Special Tribunals.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows:*

1 SECTION 1. Any justice of the supreme judi-
2 cial court or the superior court, either in term
3 time or vacation, upon the application of any
4 tribunal having authority to summon, but not
5 power to compel the attendance of witnesses and
6 the giving of testimony before it, may in his dis-
7 cretion compel the attendance of such witnesses
8 and the giving of testimony before any such tri-
9 bunal, in the same manner and to the same extent
10 as before said courts.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
