AN ACT

To change the Name of the Gold Medal Sewing
Machine Company.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives
in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the
same, as follows :*

1 SECTION 1. The Gold Medal Sewing Machine
2 Company, a corporation established in Orange under
3 the general laws, shall be known as the New
4 Home Sewing Machine Company.
