RESOLVE

In favor of Melzar W. Coombs.

Resolved, That there be allowed and paid out of the treasury to Melzar W. Coombs the sum of three hundred dollars, to defray the necessary expenses incurred and as compensation for permanent injuries received in consequence of having his foot crushed, as stated in his petition, while in discharge of his duty as a member of Battery C, First Battalion of Light Artillery, Second Brigade, Massachusetts Volunteer Militia, on the ninth of September, in the year eighteen hundred and eighty-one.
