AN ACT

Fixing the Compensation of Officers in Attendance upon Sheriffs' Juries.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

1 SECTION 1. An officer in attendance upon a sher-
2 iff's jury shall receive four dollars for each day he
3 attends upon them.

1 SECT. 2. All acts and parts of acts inconsistent
2 with the provisions of this act are hereby repealed.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
