### RESOLVE

In favor of Rice & Hutchins.

*Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth the sum of ten hundred seventy-eight and ninety-two one-hundredth dollars (\$1,078.92) to the firm of Rice & Hutchins, the same being for certain money overpaid by them for labor of certain convicts in the state prison, and interest on the same.
