### RESOLVE

In favor of the Gettysburg Battlefield Memorial Association.

*Resolved*, That there be allowed and paid out of the treasury of the Commonwealth, in aid of the Gettysburg Battlefield Memorial Association, to be paid to the treasurer of said association, upon the order of the president thereof, a sum not exceeding five thousand dollars, at such times and in such sums as his Excellency the Governor may direct; the same to be expended under the direction of the president and directors of said association, for the purchase of additional grounds of special interest upon the battlefield of Gettysburg, and for acquiring rights of way as is contemplated by the act incorporating said association, and for preserving and beautifying said battlefield: *provided*, that no part of such sum shall be paid until the Governor shall be satisfied that such lands have been purchased and conveyed to said association.
