RESOLVE

For the Publication of the Reports of Cases of Contested Elections.

*Resolved*, That the President of the Senate and the Speaker of the House of Representatives be, and they hereby are, authorized and requested to appoint and fix the compensation of two suitable persons to prepare and publish an edition of the Reports of Contested Elections of the Legislature from the year eighteen hundred and fifty-three to eighteen hundred and eighty-two inclusive, with a suitable index thereto.]

*Resolved*, That the persons so appointed include in or append to the publication hereby authorized all opinions given by the Supreme Judicial Court at the request of either branch of the Legislature relating to the several subjects contained in the same.

*Resolved*, That the number of copies of the publication hereby authorized shall not exceed one thousand, and shall be distributed as follows: one copy to be furnished to each public library in the Commonwealth, and one copy to each town in which there is no public library, the remainder to be distributed in such manner as the President of the Senate

and the Speaker of the House of Representatives may determine; and the total expense of preparing and publishing said reports shall not exceed the sum of twelve hundred dollars.
