## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Seventy-nine.

### AN ACT

To establish the Salaries of the District Attorneys and the Assistant District Attorneys, and the Clerk of the District Attorney, for the Suffolk District.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :*

1 SECTION 1. The salaries of the district attorneys  
2 for the northern, eastern, south-eastern, southern,  
3 middle, and western districts, shall be sixteen hun-  
4 dred dollars a year ; for the north-western district,  
5 twelve hundred dollars a year ; for the Suffolk district,  
6 forty-five hundred dollars a year ; and at the same  
7 rates for any part of a year.

1 SECT. 2. The salary of the first assistant district  
2 attorney for the Suffolk district shall be twenty-four  
3 hundred dollars a year ; the salary of the second  
4 assistant district attorney for the Suffolk district shall  
5 be two thousand dollars a year ; the salary of the

6 clerk of the district attorney for the Suffolk district  
7 shall be one thousand dollars a year; and at the  
8 same rates for any part of a year.

1 SECT. 3. All acts, and parts of acts, inconsistent  
2 herewith, are hereby repealed.

1 SECT. 4. This act shall take effect upon its pas-  
2 sage.
