AN ACT

To extend the Time for constructing Quinsigamond Avenue, in the City of Worcester.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :

1 SECTION 1. The time within which the city of
2 Worcester may construct the street extending from
3 Southbridge Street to Cambridge Street in said city,
4 and called Quinsigamond Avenue, laid out and es-
5 tablished by decree of the city council, adopted
6 April twenty-ninth, in the year eighteen hundred
7 seventy-eight, and assess benefits upon the estates
8 benefited thereby, as provided by chapter three
9 hundred eighty-two of the acts of eighteen hundred
10 seventy-one, is hereby extended to April twenty-
11 ninth, in the year eighteen hundred eighty-one ;
12 and, if said city shall complete said street before
13 that time, said city may assess upon the estates
14 benefited thereby the value of the benefit and

15 advantage derived therefrom, as provided in said
16 statute, in the same manner and with the same effect
17 as if said street had been completed and said assess-
18 ments made within two years from the passage of
19 said decree.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
