AN ACT

To amend Section twenty of Chapter two hundred and three of the Acts of the year eighteen hundred and seventy-six.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECT. 1. Section twenty of chapter two hun-
2 dred and three of the acts of the year eighteen
3 hundred and seventy-six is hereby amended by
4 striking out the word "may" in the tenth line and
5 inserting in its place the word "shall."

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
