AN ACT

To dissolve the Maple Street Congregational Society
in Danvers.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1 SECT. 1. The corporation known as the Maple
2 Street Congregational Society, in Danvers, a relig-
3 ious society established under the laws of the
4 Commonwealth, is hereby dissolved, subject to the
5 provisions of sections thirty-six and thirty-seven
6 of chapter sixty-eight of the General Statutes.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
