## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Seventy-Four.

### AN ACT

To incorporate the Bass River Savings Bank.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1   SECT. 1. David K. Akin, Russell D. Farris,  
2 David Kelley, Hiram Loring, their associates and  
3 successors, are hereby made a corporation by the  
4 name of the Bass River Savings Bank, to be  
5 located in South Yarmouth; with all the powers  
6 and privileges, and subject to all the duties, restric-  
7 tions and liabilities set forth in all general laws  
8 which now are or hereafter may be in force relating  
9 to institutions for savings.

1   SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
