AN ACT

To establish the Salaries of the Judge and Register of Probate and Insolvency for the County of Hampshire.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

- 1 The judge and register of probate and insolvency
- 2 for the county of Hampshire, from and after the
- 3 first day of January, in the year eighteen hundred
- 4 and seventy-four, shall receive an annual salary,
- 5 each, of fourteen hundred dollars.
