## Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

In the Year One Thousand Eight Hundred and Seventy-Three.

### AN ACT

To increase the Capital Stock of the Union Hall Association.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:*

1    SECT. 1. The Union Hall Association, at such  
2 times and by such amounts as the stockholders  
3 shall determine, may increase its capital stock, but  
4 the whole amount of said stock shall not exceed  
5 one hundred and fifty thousand dollars, and shall  
6 be divided into shares of the par value of one hun-  
7 dred dollars each.

1    SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
