### AN ACT

In addition to an Act concerning the Manufacture and  
Sale of Intoxicating Liquor.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
tives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of  
the same, as follows:—*

1 Sections two, three and five of chapter three hun-  
2 dred and thirty-four of the acts of eighteen hundred  
3 and seventy-one, are hereby repealed.
