### AN ACT

Authorizing the Eastern Railroad Company to build a  
Wharf in Salem.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-  
tives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of  
the same, as follows:—*

1   SECT. 1. License is hereby given to the Eastern  
2 Railroad Company, and its successors and assigns, to  
3 construct a wharf or wharves, either solid or on piers,  
4 across the flats in front of the estate now owned by  
5 the said corporation on Derby street in said Salem, in  
6 a direction towards the northwest side of the channel  
7 of the harbor of Salem, for such distance from the  
8 present line of the shore as may be approved by the  
9 board of harbor commissioners; and they shall have  
10 the right to lay vessels at the ends and sides of such  
11 wharf or wharves and receive dockage and wharfage

12 thereon: *provided*, that this license is given subject  
13 to the provisions of section four of chapter one hun-  
14 dred and forty-nine of the acts of the year eighteen  
15 hundred and sixty-six, and of chapter four hundred  
16 and thirty-two of the acts of the year eighteen hun-  
17 dred and sixty-nine.

1   SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-  
2 sage.
