AN ACT

To legalize a certain Town Meeting in the Town of Wenham.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—*

1    SECT. 1. The proceedings at the annual town  
2 meeting of the town of Wenham, held the first day  
3 of March, in the year eighteen hundred and seventy,  
4 and the legality of said meeting, shall in no way be  
5 affected by the fact that the warrant calling said  
6 meeting was not signed by a majority of the select-  
7 men of said town, and said meeting shall be held, to  
8 all intents and purposes, as legal as if said warrant  
9 had been signed by a majority of said selectmen.

1    SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-  
2 sage.
