AN ACT

To authorize the Stoneham Branch Railroad Company to convey its Property and Franchise to the Boston and Lowell Railroad Corporation.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. The vote of the stockholders of the
2 Stoneham Branch Railroad Company to sell and
3 transfer their property, rights, privileges and fran-
4 chise, to the Boston and Lowell Railroad Corpora-
5 tion, pursuant to the provisions of their charter,
6 chapter two hundred and sixty-eight of the acts of
7 the year eighteen hundred and fifty-nine, and the
8 vote of the stockholders of said Boston and Lowell
9 Railroad Corporation to purchase, receive and hold
10 said property, rights, privileges and franchise are
11 hereby sanctioned and confirmed, notwithstanding
12 any defects in the records of said Stoneham Branch

13 Railroad Company resulting from the decease of the
14 former clerk of said company; and the present act-
15 ing board of directors of said Stoneham Branch Rail-
16 road Company are hereby authorized to sell and
17 transfer to said Boston and Lowell Railroad Corpora-
18 tion the railroad, corporate property, rights, privi-
19 leges and franchise of said Stoneham Branch Rail-
20 road Company upon such terms as the parties may
21 mutually agree.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
