IN SENATE, February 8, 1867.

The Committee on Printing, to whom was committed the Order to consider the expediency of reporting and publishing the daily proceedings of the legislature, and the probable cost of the same, have attended to that duty, and

#### R E P O R T :

That the probable cost per day of publishing said proceedings would be thirty-five dollars, and basing the calculation on a session of one hundred and twenty-five days, the cost in round numbers would be four thousand four hundred dollars; and believing that a benefit commensurate with the expense will not be received, they consider it inexpedient to legislate thereon.
