IN SENATE, May 3, 1867.

The Committee on Roads and Bridges, to whom was committed the Petition of Lewis Chace and others, for a draw-bridge over Palmer's River, have duly considered said Petition, and report that the bridge over said river is now too low and should be raised from two to three feet, and the centre pier be removed, so that scows can pass under said bridge at any time. But the Committee do not think the towns of Somerset and Swanzey should be compelled to build a drawbridge over said river and to pay the expenses of taking care of the same. They therefore report that the petitioners have leave to withdraw.
