AN ACT

Authorizing the Fitchburg Railroad Company to construct a branch road in Waltham.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—

1 SECT. 1. The Fitchburg Railroad Company, are
2 hereby authorized to locate, construct and maintain a
3 branch railroad in the town of Waltham, beginning
4 at a point between Jackson and Elm Streets, on the
5 trunk road of said company and extending in a south-
6 westerly or southerly direction, crossing North River
7 Street at grade, to said company's branch road, called
8 the Watertown Branch Railroad.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
