### AN ACT

To authorize the North Woburn Street Railroad Company to transport Freight over its Road, and to enable said Company to lease its Road.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—*

1    SECT. 1. The North Woburn Street Railroad  
2 Company are here authorized to transport freight, in  
3 cars built for that purpose, over the whole or any  
4 portion of their railroad.

1    SECT. 2. Said North Woburn Street Railroad  
2 Company may lease their road or other property to  
3 any other railroad company, or to any party or parties.

1    SECT. 3. This act shall take effect on its passage.
