## AN ACT

To incorporate the Barre Savings Bank.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:-

- Sect. 1. Charles Brimblecom, Hiram Wads-1
- 2 worth, George Brown, their associates and successors,
- 3 are hereby made a corporation by the name of the
- 4 Barre Savings Bank, to be located in the town of

- 8 be in force in this Commonwealth relating to institu-
