### AN ACT

To incorporate the Barre Savings Bank.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—*

1   SECT. 1. Charles Brimblecom, Hiram Wads-  
2 worth, George Brown, their associates and successors,  
3 are hereby made a corporation by the name of the  
4 Barre Savings Bank, to be located in the town of  
5 Barre; with all the powers and privileges, and subject  
6 to all the duties, liabilities and restrictions set forth  
7 in all general laws which now are or may hereafter  
8 be in force in this Commonwealth relating to institu-  
9 tions for savings.

1   SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-  
2 sage.
