### AN ACT

To authorize the Administrator *de bonis non* of Abel Jewett to execute certain provisions in said Jewett's Will.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows :—*

1    SECT. 1. Samuel Parker, administrator *de bonis*  
2    *non* of the estate of Abel Jewett, late of Pepperell,  
3    is hereby authorized to execute the power conferred  
4    on the executors of said Jewett by his will, in making  
5    sale of certain land lying on the southerly side of  
5    Nashua River, in Pepperell, (formerly Groton,) known  
6    as the Lakin land, and islands in said river, and put  
7    the proceeds of said sale, to an amount sufficient to  
8    pay one hundred dollars of the annuity bequeathed  
9    to the widow of said Abel Jewett, upon interest, and

10 divide the remainder among the children of said  
11 Jewett living at the time of making his will, or the  
12 heirs of such children, in accordance with the pro-  
13 visions of said will.

1     SECT. 2.   This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
