AN ACT

To prevent the erection of Stables, in the City of Boston,
within Fifty feet of any Church.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representa-
tives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of
the same, as follows:—*

1 SECT. 1. No building shall either be erected, occu-
2 pied or used in the city of Boston, as a stable for
3 horses or other animals, within fifty feet of any church
4 or meeting-house, erected for the public worship of
5 God, without the consent in writing of the proprie-
6 tors of such church or meeting-house, or of the relig-
7 ious society or parish worshipping therein, and the
8 consent of the mayor and aldermen of the city of
9 Boston. And the supreme judicial court or any one
10 of the justices thereof, either in term time or vacation,
11 may issue an injunction to prevent such erection,
12 occupancy or use without such consent.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its pas-
2 sage.
