### AN ACT

To authorize the Congregation Ohabei Shalom to hold additional Real and Personal Estate.

*Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—*

1    SECT. 1. The Congregation Ohabei Shalom is  
2 hereby authorized to hold real and personal estate to  
3 an amount not exceeding twenty-five thousand dol-  
4 lars, in addition to the amount authorized by chapter  
5 one hundred and twenty-ninth of the acts of the year  
6 eighteen hundred and forty-five.

1    SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its  
2 passage.
