The Committee on Harbors, to whom was committed the petition of the selectmen of Marblehead to build a headway or breakwater over tide-water at the head of the harbor, report the accompanying Bill.

AN ACT

To authorize the Town of Marblehead to construct a Sea-Wall and Road over River Head Beach and Marblehead Neck.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. The town of Marblehead is hereby
2 authorized to build a road over the harbor side of
3 River Head Beach and Marblehead Neck in said town,
4 and in the construction of said road, to build and main-
5 tain a sea-wall over so much of said beach and neck as
6 may have been adjudged tide-water, said sea-wall
7 to be not more than fifty feet from, and not higher
8 than the present break-water on said beach and neck :
9 *provided*, that all things done under this act shall be
10 subject to the determination and approval of the har-
11 bor commissioners, as provided in the fourth section

12 of chapter one hundred and forty-nine of the acts of
13 the year eighteen hundred and sixty-six; and *pro-*
14 *vided*, that this license shall in nowise impair the
15 legal rights of any person; and *provided further*, that
16 this license may be revoked at any time, and shall
17 expire at the end of five years after its taking effect,
18 except so far as valuable structures may have been
19 actually and in good faith built under the same.

1 SECT. 2. This act shall take effect upon its
2 passage.
