RESOLVE

Authorizing the Commissioners of the County of Worcester to
Borrow Money.

Resolved, That the commissioners of the county of Worcester are hereby authorized to borrow, on the credit of said county, a sum of money not exceeding one hundred thousand dollars, to be expended in building a county jail, to be used also as a house of correction, at Worcester, in said county.
