PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO SENATE No. 65.

Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

Mr. BIRD, of Norfolk, moves to amend in first section by striking out all between the words "seventy-one," in fourth line, and "shall," in seventh line, and insert—

1 appoint three competent persons, who shall constitute
2 a board of valuation, and who shall hold their offices
3 for the term of one, two and three years, respectively,
4 from said last Saturday in February. The governor
5 shall, in like manner, before said last Saturday in
6 February in each year, appoint a commissioner, to
7 continue in office for the term of three years from
8 said day, and in case of any vacancy occurring in
9 the board, by resignation or otherwise, shall in like
10 manner appoint a commissioner for the residue of the
11 term, and may in the same manner remove any com-
12 missioner; and the said commissioners shall meet at
13 the state house on the first Monday in March, in the
14 year eighteen hundred and seventy-one, and each
15 year thereafter on the same day and

In section four, insert the word, "annually," between the words, "to" and "equalize."
