AN ACT

To authorize the Wellesley Congregational Society to sell Real Estate.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives, in General Court assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1 SECT. 1. The Wellesley Congregational Society,
2 formerly the Needham West Precinct, is hereby
3 authorized to sell, at public or private sale, at such
4 time or times as it may choose, a tract of land situate
5 in the village of Wellesley, in the town of Needham,
6 containing by estimation one acre: bounded northerly
7 on Central street; easterly, on land of said society;
8 south-westerly, on Common street; and westerly, on
9 land of Mary B. Field; and the treasurer of said
10 society for the time being shall have authority to
11 execute and deliver deeds to convey said land in fee
12 simple or otherwise.

1 SECT. 2. The proceeds of the sale of said land, and
2 all funds now held by said society under the will of
3 Betsey Brown, deceased, shall be by said society ap-
4 priated to and invested in the purchase and main-
5 tenance of a lot of land for burial purposes in such
6 part of said Needham as said society may elect.

1 SECT. 3. This act shall take effect from its pas-
2 sage.
